

Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Training Waiver

Certain states allow learners who have completed the first academic semester of a pre-licensure nursing program to apply for CNA certification. The following states allow learners to request a CNA Training Waiver.

Utah Learners

Learners may request a CNA training waiver from the Utah Nursing Assistant Registry (UNAR). In addition to requesting the waiver, learners must complete all other requirements for certification as prescribed by UNAR. Idaho Learners

Learners may request a CNA training waiver once the learner has completed at least one semester of actual nursing coursework. Prerequisites such as Human Anatomy and Human Physiology do not count as nursing coursework. Wyoming Learners

Learners may request a CNA training waiver once the learner has completed the first semester of a board-approved nursing program within two (2) years prior to application.
